## SUPPLIES NEEDED FOR SCHOOL YEAR

### Kindergarten:

- 1 standard size backpack (large enough for 10x13 notebook, school papers, library books, projects, etc.) **NO WHEELS**
- 1 box of facial tissues
- 1 small package of baby wipes
- 2 boxes 24 count Crayola crayons
- 2 boxes Crayola 12 count-colored pencils
- 1 pair Fiskar children's scissors
- 4 Elmer's washable glue sticks (disappearing purple)
- 1 box **each** of Ziploc snack, sandwich, quart, **and** gallon storage bags
- 1 clear reusable water bottle (to take back/ forth to school) a small travel size pillow and small lap-sized blanket for "chill"/relax time, **no full-size large pillow or blanket**
- 1 Sterilite 15-qt clear view latch container (or similar no wider than 11 in.) containing extra gym shoes, pants/shorts, collared shirt, underclothing, socks all labeled with name.
